Since North Raleigh Ministries (NRM) opened its doors in the spring of 2004, we have served more than 3,000 people, and the need continues to grow. We provide Christian encouragement, food and emergency financial aid to those in need living in the North Raleigh area. Those eligible for aid must reside in the zip codes 27609, 27612, 27613, 27614 or 27615.

Our Crisis Center, Food Pantry and Thrift Shoppe are located in North Raleigh at Pavilion Shopping Center, 2431 Spring Forest Road, #152.



Proceeds from sales at our Thrift Shoppe, which is open to the public, provide a substantial portion of our funds.

North Raleigh Ministries is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. Your gift is tax-deductible to the full extent of the law.

Who we are

Our sponsors are a community of churches who believe we are stronger when working together to answer this call to service. Participating churches pool congregational resources in order to provide overhead,

furnishings, supplies, computers and internet access.

Our volunteers are trained to assess the immediate needs of families or individuals seeking assistance, and to make decisions on providing gifts of financial aid or food.

Additional volunteers help us receive and log

gifts of non-perishable food, furniture and lamps, home décor items, toys, and clothing.

We need your support so that families in crisis can overcome their difficulties and begin to build new futures.

How we help

North Raleigh Ministries helps those in need with non-perishable food, fresh food (when available), and the everyday necessities of life. Families may apply for temporary emergency financial assistance, which may be granted following a thorough review. Financial



assistance is used to pay for rent, utilities, fuel bills, medications and similar needs, and no cash is provided directly to our clients.

We also refer our clients to other private and public resources that can provide additional assistance, from employment opportunities to housing.
