# Coaching

Participants partner with a professional coach to transform their life with purpose and arrive at a place of financial preparedness.

- Served 89 families with tailored coaching.
- 19% increase in participation.

#### **Transitions Program**

- 80% of participants reported gaining a greater sense of meaning and purpose.
- 74% increased their stability score on the Arizona Self-Sufficiency Matrix.





## **Pastoral Care**

In 2024, the newly formed Pastoral Care team provided participants with encouragement on their path to emotional and spiritual healing, helping them emerge motivated to tackle the stressful areas of their life.

- Engaged 156 clients receiving Curbside Crisis Assistance who sought support beyond food assistance.
- Increased client engagement by 60%.


